Physical Being active, coordination, control and movement, making healthy choices.	Make a fruit crumble using your favourite fruits. Take photos of how you made it.	Use scissors to cut and create a chain of paper dolls.	Cut out some Julia Donaldson characters and make some finger puppets to retell a story.

Mathematics Counting, understanding and using numbers, calculation, Shapes and measures.	Make up some subtraction number sentences and use different story characters to solve them. 	Use 3D materials to make a scarecrow from 'The Scarecrow's wedding.' You could use a tissue box, kitchen roll holder etc.	Ask your family and friends which is their favourite Julia Donaldson story and use the information to make a tally or pictogram. 
Understanding the World People, places, the world, community, technology and the environment.	Think about a super setting for a story eg The deep dark wood. Print a picture or take a photo. Are there any super settings near where you live?	Go on a woodland walk - take pictures of any animals you see. Watch out for Gruffalos!!! 	Investigate nocturnal animals and write some facts about them.
Expressive Arts and Design Art, music, movement, dance, role-play and design and technology	Make your own TRULY MAGNIFICENT BROOM!!! 	Learn a song about a story or a new nursery rhyme to perform to the class.	Design a mask of your favourite Julia Donaldson character.
